The Quadruple Aim

The goal of the Quadruple Aim is to enhance patient experience, improve population health, reduce costs, and improve the work life of health care providers, including clinicians and staff. The Quadruple Aim is widely accepted as a compass to optimise health system performance.

Better Outcomes

The goal of improving the health of the overall population.

Improved Patient Experience

Improving the patient experience aims to enhance the quality of care that patients receive, having a greater focus on individuals and families. Subjective and objective measures. Focus on quality, safety, effectiveness, patient centeredness, timeliness, efficiency and equity.



Lower Costs

Focus is on reducing the per capita cost of health care.

Improved Clinician Experience

As value-based care becomes more widespread, the provision of quality care becomes essential. The point of departure is the provider. The pressure brought to bear on clinicians is immense and leads to negative outcomes that can adversely impact the quality of care provided to the patient.

High clinician burnout is an indisputable reality. Decreased staff engagement decreases patient satisfaction, impedes positive health outcomes, and increases costs.
